

## New Speakers for Sanctuary



For several months, we have had temporary sound speakers in the sanctuary. The old speakers failed and we had them sent off in hopes they could be repaired. We have recently learned that these are not

repairable, so we have sought bids to replace the speakers.

In addition, some upgrades to the current system are included. It is our expectation that these changes will improve the sound quality for our sanctuary and our live stream as well. Included will be some sound and microphone upgrades for the chapel and fellowship hall.

While it has not yet been determined which bid we will accept, the Stewardship Committee is asking the church at the July 30 business meeting to approve spending up to \$35,000 for the project.

The committee has identified a source from undesignated funds on hand to cover the cost but would welcome any "above and beyond" contributions that individual members might want to give toward the enhancement of our sound system.




